\$5.00 Annual Registration Fee

For the annual registration, a copy of the CONTRACTORS LICENSE and a copy of their DRIVERS LICENSE are required by this office.

Annual registrations expire December 31st each year.

Electrical work shall not be started until the application for a permit has been filed with the Charter Township of East China. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Electrical Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.**

When ready for an inspection, call the Township Office at 810-765-8879 x 115 and provide as much advance notice as possible. Always provide the **job location and the permit number.**

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT

A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.
